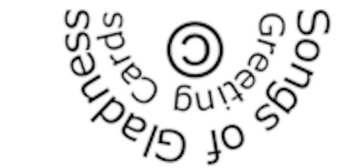

In Luke 22, Messiah and the 12 Apostles are gathered in an upper room for Passover service. “Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread drew near, which is called Passover. (Lk 22:1) ...

“And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”

“Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.” (Lk 22:19-20)
See also: Mt 26:17-30; Mk 14:12-26; Lk 22:7-23; Jn 13:1-30.

Each account provides unique details about the event. For example, the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke) emphasize Jesus' participation in the Passover service and instructing them to do it in the future in remembrance of Him: “do this in remembrance of Me.” (Lk22:19)
